## The NuGeon Caliper Numbering System

NuGeon's part numbers make it easy to identify which make - or group of makes - a caliper is for, and whether it is a left-hand (driver side) or a right-hand (passenger side) unit.

- (1): Product Type - 22: Remanufactured semi-loaded caliper.
- (2): Vehicle Origin - 0: Import; 1: Domestic
- (3): Vehicle Make - See Codes Table below.
- (4): Sequential part number within vehicle make
- (5): Position Suffix - L: Left-hand wheel; R: Right-hand wheel; -1: LH forward mount or RH rearward mount; -2: RH forward mount or LH rearward mount. When a LH caliper is identical to its RH counterpart, the part number does not have a position suffix.
